

# Changing Products VAT back to 20.00% for Absolute

# THE ANNOUNCED CHANGE IN VAT RULES

Further announcements extended the time for which the 5% VAT rate would apply, with the rate increasing to 12.5% on 1 October 2021 for a limited period, before reverting to 20% on 1 April 2022.

It was hoped that the Chancellor may have provided further support to the hospitality sector in the recent Autumn Budget by keeping the rate at 12.5%, or even taking it back down to 5%, indefinitely.

However, NO such proposals were announced in the Budget and the VAT rate will revert to 20% on 1 April 2022 as planned.

# How to change the vat rate of a product

Sign onto the till and go to the functions screen and click on programming.


Then click on products
